Required Documentation:

Please submit the following documents: (1) A statement or letter (maximum two pages) prepared and signed by the nominator describing why the nominee should receive the NBYO Lt. Governor's Distinction Award, (2) A current biography of the nominee (maximum one page). The statement should focus on the nominee's significant contributions to the NBYO, the musical development of youth, and/or the orchestral community in New Brunswick.
